



Now Enrolling for Nature Explorers Day Camp

Join us for three days of nature exploration and an opportunity to connect your child with his or her local refuge. This is a pilot program the refuge will be hosting for 8 - 12 yr olds and is limited to 20 participants. Each day children will learn about the local habitats at the refuge and their role in conservation. A special 2-hour photography workshop conducted by local photographer Dave Griffin will be part of the programming. The fee for registration will be \$150 to cover supplies and the hiring of local teen counselors. Each registrant gets a complimentary one year family membership to the Friends groups.

Each day will include hands-on nature based activities and team building. One day will be focusing on "Wacky Wetlands", a day of learning and discovery about our unique wetlands and the creatures that live within them. We will also offer fishing that same day. Day three will include a photography workshop and a close-out open house for families and friends in the afternoon. The goal of the program is to introduce children to their local national wildlife refuge and teach them about its importance to people and to wildlife. We intend to connect with the participants throughout the school year as well to maintain a relationship between them and the refuge.
